**CITY OF JOLIET CONDUCTING AN OPEN HOUSE
SUNDAY, JANUARY 15, 2017 FOR THE
NEWLY CONSTRUCTED SINGLE FAMILY HOME
LOCATED AT 409 SOUTH OTTAWA STREET**

The City of Joliet will be conducting an OPEN HOUSE this Sunday, January 15, 2017, between 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM for the newly constructed single family home located at 409 South Ottawa Street, Joliet. This two-story, three bedroom, 2 1/2 bath home is part of a larger redevelopment plan for Joliet. There are 6 more homes currently under construction in the Forest Park and Southeast Side neighborhoods. Two of the homes in the Forest Park area are ranch style one story, three bedroom, two bathroom homes that are ADA Adaptable and Accessible. The four other homes being constructed are similar to the property at 409 South Ottawa Street. Alfredo Melesio, Director of Neighborhood Services, said "This is sustainable redevelopment in good neighborhoods. A family can get assistance up to 25% in down payment for the purchase of these homes." The other locations for the homes under construction are as follows:

- 1317 Demmond-2 Story home, 3 bedroom and 2.5 baths
- 1414 Woodruff-Ranch, 3 bedroom and 2 bath, ADA Adaptable and Accessible

Southeast Side Area

- 504 Elmwood-2 Story home, 3 bedroom and 2.5 baths
- 219 Third-2 Story home, 3 bedroom and 2.5 baths
- 224 Union-2 Story home, 3 bedroom and 2.5 baths
