GLENWOOD AVENUE WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BEGINS MONDAY, JUNE 12, 2017 WASTE MANAGEMENT WILL HAVE EARLY PICK UP BEGINNING THE WEEK OF JUNE 5, 2017

Work on the Glenwood Avenue Water Main Improvement Project originally scheduled to begin on June 5, 2017, has been postponed to June 12, 2017.

The work consists of installing a new water main on Glenwood Avenue (Woodlawn to Wilcox), Wilcox (Douglas to Glenwood), and Midland (Glenwood to Campbell). The work is anticipated to take approximately six months. During the construction work there will be lane closures and modifications to traffic flow. The contractor, Austin Tyler Construction Company, will take measures to insure that residents are able to get in and out of driveways. Please use caution when driving through the construction area.

Beginning the week of June 5, 2017, and continuing through November 30, 2017, Waste Management will conduct trash, recycle, and yard waste pick-up between 6:00 AM and 7:00 AM. **It is recommended that you put all items for pick-up at the curb the night before your regularly scheduled collection day.**

Brief interruptions to water service will be necessary during the project. Additional notifications will be distributed prior to disruption of water service. Resident cooperation in the completion of this project is greatly appreciated. The City understands that this is a significant disruption; however, it is absolutely necessary.
