TREE REMOVAL (EMERALD ASH BORER) AUGUST 19 AND 20, 2017

The City of Joliet's Roadways Division will be in the following areas/subdivisions Saturday and Sunday, August 19 and 20, 2017, between the hours of 6:30 AM and 3:30 PM performing tree removals:

- Clublands Subdivision
- Wexford East Subdivision
- Warwick Subdivision
- Area bounded by Black Road-Glenwood Avenue-Raynor Avenue-Midland Avenue
- Area bounded by Western Avenue-Ingalls Avenue-Raynor Avenue-DesPlaines River

Please refrain from parking on these streets on these days during these hours, and remember to proceed with caution while workers are present. There will be occasions where roadways will be closed to through traffic due to tree removal operations. Residents should expect traffic delays in these areas as they remove ash trees.

Thank you for your patience. This will be **tree removals only**. The Roadways Division crews will return at a later date to perform stump grinding.
