## **Winter Storm Warning for the City of Joliet**

The City of Joliet is under a winter storm warning effective 6:00 p.m. today through 9:00 p.m. Friday evening. It is anticipated that the Joliet area will get approximately 11 inches of snow during this period (with 6 inches of snow fall totals by 6:00 a.m. on Friday). All snowplows are expected to be on the streets by 6:00 p.m. this evening and will be on the roads as continuous as possible until the event ends late Friday afternoon. Residents should not expect to see bare pavement until Saturday or Sunday at the earliest.

The Snow Parking Ban will be in effect during this event. All vehicles must be moved off of public streets until the City of Joliet's snow plow trucks have had a chance to plow the snow on the street. Once the snow plow trucks have cleared the street by your home or business, you may move your vehicle back to the street. Some older neighborhoods in Joliet do not have adequate off-street parking options. In those areas residents are encouraged to seek permission from neighbors who have off-street parking spaces and other parking options such as commercial or church parking lots that will allow streets to be clear of vehicles for all snow clearing efforts to be effective. The Joliet Police Department will have the option of issuing a parking ticket to the owner of a vehicle left on a City Street during a snow event as well as having the option of having the vehicle towed, or both. All towing and storage costs will be the responsibility of the vehicle owner.
